



Teen Learning Lab

Program Description: Aspiring Youth's Teen Learning Lab aims to address the needs of neurodiverse adolescents as most school systems adopt online programming in the fall. Our teens need a supportive social environment to combat isolation and continue to build their organizational, communication, and friendship skills during this challenging time.

Participants in the Teen Learning Lab will have an opportunity to sign up for Full Time all-day programming, which includes assistance with accessing online learning in a social classroom environment, and Part Time afternoon interactive social and recreational programming.

Schedule Outline (will adapt as school schedules are released):

- 8:45am Full Time arrival and check-in
- 9am-12pm Full Time participants take part in their online classes with the assistance of a Lead Facilitator. During breaks, participants engage in social and study-skill activities.
- 12-12:30pm Social Lunch Time and outdoor movement break
- 12:30-2:45pm Full Time participants take part in their afternoon online programming and/or complete schoolwork in a group with guidance from the Lead Facilitator.
- 2:45-4:45pm Part Time participants arrive along with additional staff, and Full Time participants wrap up schoolwork to join in a larger group for outdoor social activities (field games, basketball, challenge course, time in community gardens, walks to parks, etc.)

Where: Aspiring Youth's Ryther Campus 2400 NE 95th St, Seattle, WA 98115

When: Full Time: Monday-Friday 8:45am-4:45pm

Part Time: Monday-Friday 2:45pm-4:45pm

Program has rolling enrollment with a 10-week minimum registration for each cycle. Current participants will be given priority to extend registration through the end of the cycle should need continue.

Who: Teens ages 13-18 who have completed an Enrollment Meeting with Aspiring Youth. Groups will be capped at 7-8 participants with one Lead for the school days and two for afternoons.

Fees: Each option includes two phone consultations with a Lead Facilitator. Full Time participants will also receive coordination between the morning Lead and their child's school Case Manager.

- Full Time for 10 weeks option \$8,000
- Part Time for 10 weeks option \$2,000

COVID-19 Safety: The Teen Learning Lab program will adhere to all county, state, and federal guidelines set for youth programming and childcare, including social distancing, mask wearing, and daily symptom checks.
