Palos Verdes Peninsula High School is very proud to present its thirty-first graduating class, the Class of 2022. Peninsula’s ASB and Graduation Committee have organized many activities which honor and reward seniors for their four years of hard work. Parents may share in some of the activities, while other activities are reserved exclusively for students. It is our intent, through this informational bulletin, to acquaint you with all the activities which your son or daughter is entitled to attend and those in which you would have an interest. We request that you review this bulletin with your son or daughter.

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GRADUATION ASSEMBLY	Wednesday, April 13, 2022 2nd, 3rd, 4th Periods
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An assembly will be held for all seniors. All information concerning graduation, grad night, and senior activities will be explained in detail. **It is mandatory that all seniors attend this very important assembly. Seniors will be excused from 2nd, 3rd and 4th period to attend the assembly, panoramic photo and to pick up their gown.**

SENIOR PANORAMIC PHOTO FOOTBALL FIELD	Wednesday, April 13, 2022 2nd, 3rd & 4th Periods
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After the assembly all seniors will proceed to the football stadium to take the Senior Panoramic photo. The photo is taken on the visitor's side of the football bleachers. The cost for the photo is \$30 for a 10x30 or \$20 for a 5 x 15 or can be ordered with a graduation handshake photo (taken at Graduation on 6/9) for \$50. The photos will be mailed to the students' homes. **The order form for the panoramic photo us included in this mailing or you can go to <https://vando.imagequix.com/g1000909380#login> to place your order. The order must be received by June 7th.**

CAP AND GOWN DELIVERY GYM	Wednesday, April 13, 2022 11:15 am
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Moon Grad Services of Herff Jones's graduation product delivery date is Wednesday, April 13, 2022. Seniors report to the cap and gown distribution station in the gym immediately after the panoramic photo. Check the cap and gown package to make sure it is complete. Cap and gown packages should include a cap, gown, tassel and medallion. If something is missing or the size seems wrong, call Dallas Moon at (805) 910-9294 or email moongradservices@gmail.com. If your student purchased the gown, cap, tassel and medallion, he or she will keep all of those items after Graduation. If your student requested a loaner by the December deadline, then the gown, cap, tassel and medallion must all be returned to the Herff Jones representatives immediately following Graduation. Diplomas will not be given to students who requested loaners until the loaner gowns, caps, tassels and medallions are returned immediately following Graduation. Once all 4 items are returned, students receive a receipt, verifying the return. Counselors will give diplomas to students once they show their gown return receipt. **If your student did not meet the deadlines to rent/purchase a gown, please bring \$60 cash (they will not accept checks) to the Cap and Gown Delivery on April 13th, and the Moon Grad Services company will sell your student a cap, gown, tassel and medallion.**

SELECTION OF GRADUATION SPEAKERS/MUSICIANS P115/Band room/Choir Room	Thursday, April 21 2:45 until 4:00 pm
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Every senior in the graduating class is eligible and encouraged to try out for class speaker or performer at Graduation. Graduation is Thursday, June 9 at 6 pm in the football stadium. No senior is automatically speaking at Graduation (valedictorians, class officers included). Everyone must audition to perform or speak. Speeches are traditional and should be around three or four minutes in length. Seniors also may choose to try out with a piece of music (either vocal or instrumental).

Seniors may sign up to audition now in the Activities Office, P115.

An important note: students auditioning to perform at graduation must have all performers present at the audition; similarly, all students auditioning to speak at graduation are expected to have their final drafts prepared when they audition. The Graduation Committee and selected faculty members will choose the speeches and performances that best reflect the nature of the Graduation ceremony.

FIRST POSTING OF SENIOR OBLIGATIONS	Monday, April 25, 2022
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Seniors who have lost or damaged school equipment or supplies (i.e., textbooks, library books, parking passes, science equipment, athletic uniforms or equipment, etc.) and have not paid for them will find their names and the amounts due on the Obligation List. Charges for sending transcripts to schools and scholarship committees that were not paid when they were ordered will also appear on the Obligations List. The list will be posted outside the Library and Attendance Office. Tickets for the graduation ceremony, as well as the diploma, will be withheld until the debt is paid. Seniors are encouraged to clear their obligations and pay the amount due at the Student Store as soon as possible. The second posting of senior obligations (on June 5) will cover second-semester obligations, in addition to unpaid obligations from the first posting.

SENIOR WEEK	Monday, April 25- Friday, April 29, 2022
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Throughout this week, the senior class will be celebrated with lunchtime or evening activities. The Senior Participation Donation includes the Senior Class shirt and free giveaways.

COMPLETE SENIOR SURVEY	Friday, May 13, 2022
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Seniors, please complete the senior surveys on SchoolLinks. The survey enables the Counseling Office and College Career Center to generate reports and create the PVPHS college acceptance data. Additionally, we will be asking each the student give permission for his/her path after high school to be published in the June issue of the school newspaper, *The Pen*. SENIOR DITCH DAY- DISNEYLAND	Tuesday, May 17, 2022 8:00 AM – 10:00 PM
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A permission slip for Senior Ditch Day was sent out via Aeries in March and the check was due in the Student Store in March. The price included the Park hopper ticket into both Disneyland and California Adventure, as well as transportation to and from the parks. Seniors who do not attend Senior Ditch Day are expected to attend school that day. Because of insurance and liability regulations, seniors may not join the class at Disneyland unless they have purchased a ticket and have arrived at Disneyland with the group. Use of private transportation is not permitted to or from Disneyland. It is appropriate to send money for the day with your child. Encourage your child to bring sunscreen, a hat and a sweatshirt or sweater. If you child already has a pass to Disneyland, he or she must have still paid a Transportation Fee of \$25 to ride the bus.

DECLARE DAY	Wednesday, May 18, 2022
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Declare Day is when seniors who are continuing their education after Peninsula High School can proudly wear the attire from the school or institution they plan to be a part of next year. Pictures will be taken during lunchtime in the amphitheater.

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The Prom, a formal dinner dance for Peninsula High School juniors and seniors, will be held at The Belasco Theatre on Saturday, May 21 from 6:30 until 10:30 pm. The price of a ticket per person is the following:

The student store will close at 3:00 pm on Wednesday, May 18. Tickets may not be purchased after 3:00 pm on May 18. The ticket includes dinner, dessert, dancing, formal pictures, casual pictures, and various activities. In order to attend Prom, every couple must include one person who is currently a junior or senior at Peninsula High School or Rancho Del Mar. If your child's date is not a student of Peninsula High School or Rancho Del Mar, your child must complete a Guest Pass Form, which is available at pvphs.pvpusd.net. The last day a Guest Pass Form may be turned in is Wednesday, May 18.

Admission to the Prom is by ticket only. Please note that the doors to the Prom will close at 7:30 pm. Students may leave the Prom at anytime, but once students leave, they may not re-enter. Peninsula High School will be offering a safe and affordable transportation option for students. Students wishing to take chartered buses may do so for \$25 per person. The buses will be chaperoned by PVPHS staff members.

All students going to Prom must fill out the Prom Contract/Emergency Card/Transportation Form provided in this mailer on pg 9-10. The Contract/Transportation Form must be turned in at the time the Prom ticket is purchased. Students may not purchase a ticket to Prom without the Transportation Form signed by their parent/guardian.

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Each senior will be given eight (8) graduation tickets. These graduation tickets will be distributed following the rehearsal on June 8, 2022. IF you need MORE THAN EIGHT TICKETS, your son or daughter must sign up for extra tickets in the Main Office beginning Wednesday, May 25. **YOUR CHILD MAY ONLY SIGN UP FOR SIX (6) EXTRA TICKETS! (14 total). Please have your child request extra tickets for you; do not phone or fax in requests for extra tickets.** All graduation tickets, including additional requested tickets, are distributed following the rehearsal on June 8, 2022.

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Handicapped seating and parking is available for graduation on a first-come, first-served basis. Seniors or their parents may submit a request online at pvphs.pvpusd.net. Check under 'Panther Picks'. The link will be available on Wednesday, May 25, 2022 beginning at 9:30 am. The link will request the following information:

Graduate's name, name of person/people requiring handicapped seating, number of seats and parking spots you are requesting, email address of best person to contact regarding your request

There are a limited number of parking spaces and seats available. Handicapped seating is not available for entire families; please arrange for just one person to sit with the handicapped person in your group. All graduation tickets, including handicapped seating and parking tickets, are distributed following the rehearsal on June 8.

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Memory Lane is an exhibition of posters that each senior or parent will put together. This poster will represent the graduate’s life in pictures from childhood through senior year and will be displayed at Senior Sunset and Graduation Ceremony.

Start Collecting Your Photos Now!

Here is what you need to do:

1. Use one 22”x 28” poster board (standard thickness - NO foam boards)
2. Collect a variety of photos (from baby to senior year) and make color copies of each photo.
3. Glue color copies onto the poster board (DO NOT glue original photos on the board).
4. Another way to make a poster is to go to one of several on-line photo centers. Shutterfly, Rite-Aid, and CVS are just a few of the on-line photo centers that generate posters. Upload your photos to their website and let the photo center do the work for you. Their posters may be a slightly different size, but that’s OK.
5. Make sure your Senior’s Name is on the front (identifying who it is). Also, write your Senior’s Name, Phone number and Parent’s Email Address on the back of the poster.
6. Laminate the finished poster. Some suggested places to laminate: Office Max, Costco, and FedEx Office
7. Please deliver your finished, laminated poster to the Student Store no later than Friday, May 20, 2022.
8. Your poster may be picked up after Graduation on June 9 or at the PVPHS Student Store weekdays during the week of June 13 (10am-3pm). Any unclaimed posters will be discarded after June 28.

1. Seniors who fail a class as a result of failing a final exam may not meet graduation requirements. In that event, their counselor will notify them.

2. Seniors who do not meet graduation requirements may participate in the graduation exercises under certain conditions. Note: Board of Education Administrative Regulation 2127 states (effective Class of 1981):

“To be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony, students shall have satisfied the credit, subject and competency requirements contained in Board Policy 2122 (Credit, Subject and Competency Requirements for High School Graduation). The only exceptions to this provision shall be students who have five or fewer credits remaining to be completed, who are eligible to complete such credits in the immediately ensuing summer session, and who have obtained the advance approval of the Principal. With the approval of the Principal, a senior who has not satisfied all requirements for graduation shall nonetheless be permitted to participate in senior activities.”

MANDATORY GRADUATION REHEARSAL (NO EXCEPTIONS) AMPHITHEATER	Wednesday, June 8, 2022 1:15 – 3:00 PM
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1. Seniors are asked to report to the amphitheater promptly at 1:15 pm where instruction will be given to the entire class. Your child does not need to bring his/her cap and gown for the rehearsal.
2. The rehearsal will proceed smoothly and on schedule if all seniors cooperate fully in following the directions. Graduation rehearsal normally lasts 1½ - 2 hours.
3. **Seniors with jobs must make advance arrangements with their employers to attend the rehearsal.**

DISTRIBUTION OF GRADUATION TICKETS- HAWTHORNE AND SILVER SPUR OFFICES	Wednesday, June 8, 2022
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1. **Following Graduation Rehearsal-** Each senior will be given eight (8) tickets. **If your family requires MORE THAN EIGHT TICKETS, your son or daughter must sign up for extra tickets** in the main office **beginning Wednesday, May 25, 2022**. These tickets will be assigned on a first-come first- served basis only. **YOUR CHILD MAY ONLY REQUEST SIX EXTRA TICKETS! Please have your child request extra tickets for you; do not phone or fax in requests for extra tickets.**
2. Students who do not need their entire allotment of eight tickets are asked to make one of the administrative assistants in the Main Office aware of that as soon as possible so that extra tickets can be given to those who need them.
3. Remember that clearance of obligations is a prerequisite to receiving graduation tickets.
4. Tickets will be distributed from the windows of the Hawthorne and Silver Spur offices following graduation rehearsal.

SECOND POSTING OF SENIOR OBLIGATIONS	Wednesday, June 8, 2022
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The updated Obligations List, including charges for the second semester, will be posted at 8:00 am. Seniors should take care of their obligations promptly so that their tickets and diplomas may be released. The first posting of senior obligations will occur on Monday, April 25, 2022.

GRADUATION EXERCISES FOOTBALL STADIUM	Thursday, June 9, 2022 6:00 PM
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Seniors will report to the amphitheater for the processional no later than 5:15 PM.

During the ceremony, we will read the names of graduates from two microphones, one on each side of the stage. Yells, cheers, or other inappropriate noise after a student’s name is read completely drowns out the name of the next student receiving a diploma. Not only does the noise disturb others, but it also robs another family of their right to hear the name of their graduate.

Parking for the commencement exercises will be available in the student and faculty parking lots. Please submit an online request to arrange parking and seating for handicapped guests (See page 4 for details).

Graduation is a ceremony of dignity, and guests are expected to dress and act appropriately. Please do not stand on the chairs to take pictures. **RULE: We will not permit any photographers (family or otherwise) to approach**

the stage during the ceremony for any reason. Of course, we will permit pictures as the graduating class enters the stadium. The stage will be left in order following the ceremony so family pictures may be taken.

The actual diploma will not be issued until after the ceremony and will be released only to the graduating senior. If your student does not wish to pick up his/her diploma after the Graduation ceremony, he/she may come to the Counseling Office beginning Mon, June 13, 2022 and pick it up. However, if your student is unavailable, you must have a note from your child that clearly states you have his or her permission to pick up the diploma. Your child's diploma belongs to him/her and can only be released to you with his/her permission.

Hard-soled shoes or dress shoes (no tennis or athletic shoes, sandals, boots, slippers, or flip flops)
Dress shirt and tie, Long pants or slacks (no jeans)

Hard-soled shoes or dress shoes (no tennis or athletic shoes, sandals, boots, slippers, or flip flops)
Skirt and blouse, dress or appropriate pants (no jeans), No halter tops or shorts

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Palos Verdes Peninsula High School 2022 Prom Rules

1. All rules in the Safe Schools Policy are in effect.
2. Due to the fluid Covid situation, Peninsula High School may require Covid testing, proof of vaccination, and/or masks to enter the venue. When tickets go on sale, Peninsula High School will share the requirements on our school website, via the Daily Bulletin, and via the Principal's Update.
3. All guests attending Prom are the responsibility of the PVPHS students with whom they are attending the event. As such, violating school policy and/or Ed Code may result in both students being asked to leave. The responsibility of picking up the attendees will fall upon the PVPHS parents.
4. Doors to the Prom will open at 6:30 pm; students may not enter Prom after 7:30 pm.
5. Students may leave the Prom at any time, but once they leave, they may not re-enter.
6. Students may be randomly breathalyzed.
7. All students will be searched before entering Winter Formal. The following items are not acceptable and will be confiscated by security guards:
 - Glow in the Dark Items
 - Gum/Open Mint Containers
 - Wallet Chains
 - Markers
 - Pens/Pencils
 - Lighters/Matches
 - Water Bottles or Glass Bottles
 - Canes & Zoot Chains
 - Liquid Items, including bottled water and drinks
 - Containers with a screw-on cap or lid including:
 - perfume/cologne bottles, eye drops, mouthwash
8. Students may receive disciplinary action if caught in possession of any of these items:
 - Alcohol/Flasks
 - Weapons
 - All Tobacco Products
 - Any item(s) that can be used as a weapon
 - Sharp Objects
 - Any Illegal Substance
9. Parents or the person on the emergency card will be called to immediately transport students home if violations of safe school's policy and/or Education Code occur. Parents will be asked to pick up their students if the school believes they are under the influence of any substance. Violations may result in seniors not participating in end of year activities, including walking at Graduation. If the listed contacts are unavailable for pick-up, local police will be called for assistance.
