Students may start soliciting pledges today! We are using PledgeStar once again this year. Once you have created your account, donations can be made with a Debit Card, Credit Card or PayPal account. Please note, you will have to create a PledgeStar account even if you created one last year. If you use the same email, you will be able to import all your same information from previous years. Please also register your runner after you have setup your account.

Create your own fundraising page

- Go to http://pledgestar.com/bonnyslope
- Enter your name and email address, then click Register
- Follow the instructions on-screen
 - PledgeStar will send a passcode to your email address, allowing you to finish your registration.
 - Once you've registered your joggers, click "Add Family & Friends" to send out fundraising link (even to yourself).
- When you finish, the system emails pledge requests to your family and friends, and allows them to make secure credit card/PayPal donations online.

FAQ

How does the actual Jog-A-Thon work?

This year's Jog-A -Thon is going to be a week-long event. Starting on Monday, May 3rd -Sunday, May 9th students are encouraged to run, jog or walk one or all of the loops listed above. Our hope is to have students log as many miles as they can throughout the week.

Do matching funds count toward prizes?

Matching Funds are invaluable for maintaining the enriching programs of BSCO; however, they do not count toward overall dollar amounts for individual prize awards.

How do we log our miles?

Parents can assist their students in logging their miles on their PledgeStar account. These are going to be used for a couple fun purposes, but no pressure here! Only whole miles can be input into PledgeStar so here are some examples to use as a guideline:

- Blackhawk Loop = .44 miles Run it twice and enter 1 mile in PledgeStar
- Bluffs Loop = .53 miles Run it twice and enter 1 mile in PledgeStar
- Bauer Loop = .81 miles Run it once and maybe add a little extra to or from your house and enter 1 mile in PledgeStar
- Timbercreek Loop= .44 miles- Run it twice and enter 1 mile in PledgeStar

Why are we not accepting cash/checks this year?

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we can only accept online payment options this year. We can no longer accept cash or checks. We have no way of collecting donations in person or at the school.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

All generated Jog-A-Thon funds are used in BSCO's yearly operating budget. This year, BSCO is budgeted to spend \$40,000 on student enrichment, teacher support, administrative costs and most of the programs/events that kept the students connected to the BSE community.
