(2) "Institution of higher 12 education," notwithstanding Section 51.451, has the meaning assigned by Section 13 14 61.003. 15 (b) Not later than the 30th day before the first day that 16 classes are conducted for each semester or academic term, each institution of higher education shall: 17 18 (1) compile a course schedule indicating each course offered by the institution for the semester or term to 19 postsecondary students; 20 21 (2) with respect to each course, include with the

schedule, or provide in a prominent location in the schedule a link

to an Internet website, such as the Internet website of a college

bookstore, that contains, a list of the required and recommended

- 3 (c) As soon as practicable after the information becomes
- 4 available, each institution of higher education shall make
- 5 available specific information regarding any revisions to the
- 6 institution's course schedule and course materials list.
- 7 (d) An institution of higher education shall itemize a fee
- 8 or charge for course materials assessed by the institution or
- 9 another entity under an agreement with the institution separately
- 10 from any other fees or charges assessed for a course or course
- 11 section in the institution's billing to the student. This
- 12 subsection may not be construed to prohibit an institution of
- 13 higher education from including the cost of course materials as

- 15 <u>(e) Any agreement between an institution of higher</u>

- 20 (f) To allow for timely placement of course material orders
- 21 by students, each institution of higher education shall establish a
- 22 deadline by which faculty members must submit information to be
- 23 included in the course schedule and course materials list required
- 24 by Subsection (b).
- 25 (g) If an institution of higher education or a college
- 26 bookstore publishes a course materials list with a course schedule
- 27 on an Internet website that provides a search function, the

- 2 (1) ensure that the search function permits a search
- 3 <u>based on whether a course or section of a co</u>urse requires or
- 4 recommends only open educational resources; or
- 5 (2) provide a searchable list of courses and sections
- 6 of courses that require or recommend only open educational

- 8 (h) If an institution of higher education designates in the
- 9 institution's course schedule certain courses or sections of
- 10 courses as having low course material costs or a similar
- 11 designation, the institution shall, in a prominent location in the
- 12 schedule, state or provide an Internet website link to the criteria
- 13 for that designation.
- 14 (i) This section may not be construed to affect any
- 15 <u>authority granted to a faculty member by an institution of higher</u>
- 16 education to select course materials for courses taught by the
- 17 faculty member.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.451, Education Code, is amended by
- 19 amending Subdivision (4) and adding Subdivision (4-b) to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 (4) "Institution of higher education" means:
- 22 (A) an institution of higher education as defined
- 23 by Section 61.003; or
- 24 (B) a private or independent institution of
- 25 higher education [as defined by Section 61.003].
