3	<ul> <li>Cheating on a quiz or test (having or using a paper or electronic "cheat sheet," cell phone, electronic translator, etc. without explicit teacher permission; communicating in any unauthorized form during a quiz or test, soliciting answers from another student, submitting another student's test as your own, etc.)</li> <li>Plagiarizing* on an essay</li> <li>Working together on a take-home exam unless specifically authorized by the teacher</li> </ul>		<ul> <li>Zero on assignment/test/etc.</li> <li>Referral/Counseled/Parent notified</li> <li>Saturday school to complete Integrity Packet/Trash pickup/School service</li> <li>3 points added to Student Infraction Record</li> </ul>
4	<ul> <li>Gaining or providing unauthorized access to exam materials</li> <li>Reproducing or taking a picture of a test</li> </ul>		<ul> <li>Zero on assignment/test/etc.</li> <li>Referral/Parent notified</li> <li>Saturday school to complete Integrity Packet/Trash pickup/School service</li> <li>Honor Society adviser will enforce the policy of the Honor Society in question</li> <li>Possible impact on club/athletic eligibility</li> <li>Ineligible for ASB elected positions</li> <li>4 points added to Student Infraction Record</li> </ul>
When a total of 5 points is reached on the Student Infraction Record:		<ul> <li>Zero on assignment/test/etc.</li> <li>Referral/Parent notified</li> <li>Honor Society Adviser will enforce the policy of the Honor Society in question</li> <li>Administrative council will be convened to determine consequences</li> <li>Possible drop from class with an F and a U</li> <li>Possible behavior contract</li> </ul>	
When a total of 6 or more points is reached on the Student Infraction Record and for each subsequent infraction:		<ul> <li>Dropped from class where incident occurred with an F and a U</li> <li>Honor Society Adviser will enforce the policy of the Honor Society in question</li> <li>Probable impact on club/athletic/election eligibility</li> </ul>	
If a student steals a test, changes grades in a teacher's computer, or engages in other illegal behavior:		<ul> <li>Suspension</li> <li>Arrest</li> <li>Recommended for expulsion</li> </ul>
