WHAT NEEDS TO CHANGE?

Violence experienced by women and girls is significantly underreported, only 40 per cent of women who experience violence seek help of any sort and many do not report their experiences to formal mechanism.

There is a Gender-Based Violence global emergency.

Women and girls in all their diversity experience multiple and intersecting forms of gender-based violence in their lifetime.

Emerging evidence shows that since the outbreak of COVID-19, reports of gender-based violence against women and girls have increased.

GBV against women and girls is deeply rooted in social and gendered norms, attitudes and beliefs.

Patriarchal backlash against women's rights and limited political will hinder change.

An estimated 736 million women - almost 1 in 3 - have been subjected to intimate partner violence, non-partner sexual violence or both at least once in their life.

Almost 1 in 4 adolescent girls aged 15-19 (24%) have experienced physical and/or sexual violence from an intimate partner or husband at least once in their lifetime.

- 55 more countries will outlaw child marriage without exception and FGM will be banned in ¾ of practicing countries

- Increase by 50% the number of countries that include one or more evidence-driven prevention strategies on gender-based violence against women and girls in national policies by 2026
- Increase by 25% the number of people who endorse gender equitable beliefs in every country by 2026
- Increase investment in evidence-driven prevention strategies by \$500 Million USD by 2026
