




I-94 East-West Corridor Benchmark




Over seven-in-ten voters travel I-94 at least once a month.

How often would you say you travel on Interstate Ninety-Four by the Stadium between the Marquette and Zoo interchanges?




Voters in Milwaukee and the work area are taking I-94 more often than those in Waukesha.

How often would you say you travel on Interstate Ninety-Four by the Stadium between the Marquette and Zoo interchanges?




Over seven-in-ten voters support the one-billion-dollar plan to improve I-94 while a majority opposes an \$850 million dollar option.

Investing one billion dollars to improve Interstate Ninety-Four near the Stadium between the Marquette and Zoo interchanges; including, rebuilding the freeway and bridges, adding a lane in each direction to ease congestion, modifying interchange access to improve safety and traffic flow and reconstructing affected local streets.




Investing \$850 million dollars to improve Interstate Ninety-four near the stadium between the Marquette and Zoo interchanges; including, rebuilding the freeway and bridges, modifying interchange access to improve safety and traffic flow and reconstructing affected local streets. However, this plan WOULD NOT add a lane in each direction to ease congestion and WOULD NOT have ALL of the traffic flow and safety benefits related to the additional capacity and reduced congestion.



The one-billion-dollar plan has support across the key groups. The \$850 million dollar option is opposed by all key groups.
