Graduates lead evidence-based secondary transition services that promote positive postschool outcomes for students with disabilities.

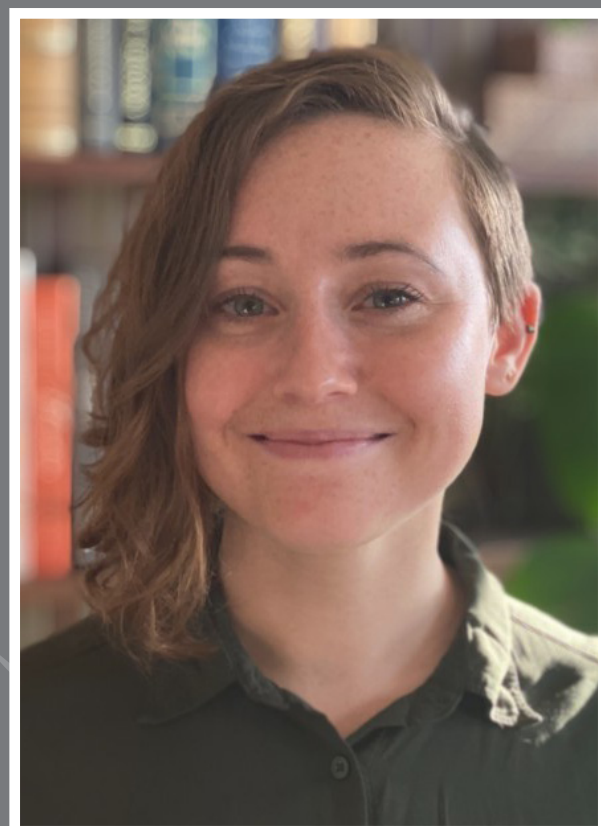
