The purpose of the scholarship is to honor and perpetuate the memory of Jack Lippe and to assist a deserving high school graduate in the pursuit of higher education.

The scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who are planning to attend an accredited college or industrial, trade, or business school. The parents must be members of Congregation Agudath Israel, and the father a member of Men's Club. If the household does not have a father who is a member of the congregation, but the mother is a member, that is acceptable.

The size of the award is established by the Men's Club Board based upon the recommendations of the Jack Lippe Scholarship committee. The amount of the scholarship each year will be based upon availability of funds and the qualifications of the applicants.

In awarding the scholarship, the committee uses the following criteria: the student's scholastic achievement, personal character, extracurricular activities, and Jewish community involvement. Each of these criteria will be weighed equally in evaluating the recipient. The scholarship committee may choose to conduct personal interviews with finalists.

The scholarship will be awarded at the annual Men's Club Shabbat in May, 2024. We request that both the applicant and father attend.
