

Homebound COVID-19 Vaccine Updates

Below are Homebound COVID-19 Vaccination Updates by County:

Bucks:

Homebound patients: Taking names for homebound list. Email <u>vacfacts@buckscounty.org</u> with "Homebound" in the Subject line. Include the following: Name, DOB, telephone number, home address and email (if applicable).

Bucks County Transport will provide round trip transportation to Bucks County residents for vaccination appointments in Bucks County. Rides are available from Monday – Friday from 6 AM to 6 PM. Call Bucks County Transport at 888-795-0740 (M-F 8 AM to 4 PM) at least two days in advance of your vaccination appointment. Riders aged 65 and over will be required to register for Bucks County Transport's Shared Ride Program to receive a free ride. Applications can be found on Bucks County Transport's Website www.bctransport.org, by calling 888-795-0740, or through this BCT application (pdf). Applications must be received by Bucks County Transport within 30 days of your reservation.

In accordance with updated state and federal vaccination eligibility mandates, Bucks County: Has removed its wait list and those aged 16+ to register and schedule an appointment now at https://www.trackmyvaccine.com/register

Doylestown Hospital is currently vaccinating patients of practices associated with Doylestown Health. The practices on the hospital's medical staff are given a specific number of patients they can schedule per week based on the number of providers and size and relevance of their practice. The vaccinations are taking place at Doylestown Hospital and Doylestown Health Urgent Care. The practices are reaching out to their patients to schedule them through our enterprise-wide electronic medical record. We are following the state's guidelines regarding eligibility.
