

Rules:

- All classes require proper attire for the event Boots, Long Sleeve Shirt, Hat/Helmet, Coat, Etc. (Hat not required for Speed Events)
- 2. No minor entry will be accepted without parent/guardian signature.
- 3. Horse must be entered in HALTER and THREE RIDING EVENTS to gualify for HIGH POINT AWARD in Judged Events Only

Halter is not required for riders entering only the speed events.

- 4. HIGH POINT AWARD based on 1 horse/1 rider. Must declare for HIGH POINT at registration
- 5. Entry in Walk/Trot classes-rider will not be eligible to lope in any other riding class. Must declare for Walk/Trot HIGH PIONT at registration. Class for Beginner Riders only
- Other than stated above, State 4-H Horse Show Rules & AQHA rules will prevail.
