- Completed and signed Marriage and Family Therapist License Application
- \$306.00 Non-refundable Application Fee
- Fingerprint-Based Background Check Processed
- National Provider Identifier Number (if applicable)
- Out-of-State Credential Verification Form
- Official graduate transcript(s) [If program is Non COAMFTE you must list each course. If title does not describe the content the applicant will need to provide an official syllabus, official course outline or statement from the professor]
- Approved Supervisor Verification Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist Form and Supervision and Experience Verification Form
 - If the applicant has been fully licensed, in good standing, and without a disqualifying criminal history for over five years, the Washington State Department of Health does not require the applicant to obtain and provide proof of supervision hours. If the applicant has been licensed for less than five years, or if the applicant has disciplinary or criminal history, within the past 5 years, then the applicant would be required to have their previous supervisor(s) sign the Washington State Department Health’s forms to verify their supervised experience.
- Test scores for the AMFTRB National Examination in Marital and Family Therapy
- Continuing Education Attestation Form confirming completion of 36-hours of continuing education, with 6-hours in professional ethics
- The department will review if any additional deficiencies exist on a case-by-case basis

A California Marriage and Family Therapist seeking licensure through reciprocity, who is deficient in a requirement, may apply for a temporary probationary license. The probationary license will typically be the best option if the applicant does not meet all education requirements, post-graduation supervised experience requirements, and/or needs time to prepare for and take the approved examination. With the passage of HB 1724, a probationary license allows the applicant to work with Washington clients in any setting. The following will be needed for the probationary license:

- All of the requirements above (minus the deficiency(s) that is causing the applicant to apply for the probationary license)
- \$290.00 Probationary License Fee
- Out-of-State Credential Verification Form indicating the applicant has been licensed for at least 12 months with no disciplinary action
- The department will review if any additional requirements are needed on a case-by-case basis
