
# college transition/dual enrollment program for NYC DOE high school students. It offers college credit courses aligned with first year study at CUNY, pre-college courses that prepare students to start college without remediation, college awareness courses and activities, full day summer programs, and access to CUNY campus facilities and events.

College Now started in the spring of 1984 at Kingsborough Community College with 449 students. In 2000, a partnership was formed between CUNY and NYC DOE to expand to 17 CUNY undergraduate colleges and today more than 22,000 students from over 470 NYC DOE high schools participate in College Now.

In College Now, students can earn up to 15 CREDITS FOR FREE, which translates to a SAVINGS OF OVER \$4,000 in tuition at a 4-year CUNY college.

Students get a college transcript from CUNY showing the grade and credits they earned.

Credits earned in College Now are accepted at all CUNY, most SUNY and many private colleges and count towards the annual credits needed to qualify for the New York State Excelsior Scholarship.



# College Now courses are available in a wide variety of subjects:

art and music, anthropology, accounting, biology, business, chemistry, communications, classics, computer science, criminal justice, drama, education, English, engineering, foreign language, forensic science, graphic design, health, history, mathematics, marketing, political science, psychology, sociology, speech communication, theatre, video production, and many more.




### **COLLEGE NOW SUCCESS RATE**



Over 85% of students in fall and spring (over 95% in the summer program) earn a passing grade of A, B or C in a College Now credit course.

A college grade is determined by students' work over the whole semester—class participation, projects, term papers, quizzes, mid-term and final exams, not a single high stakes exam.
