US Goats and Kids Inventory Down 1 Percent

All goat inventory in the United States on January 1, 2022 totaled 2.55 million head, down 1 percent from 2021. Meat and all other goats totaled 2.03 million head, down 1 percent from the previous year. Milk goat inventory was 410,000 head, down 2 percent from the previous year. Alabama all goat inventory totaled 47,500 head, 6 percent below last year. In Florida, the all goat inventory totaled 53,000 head, 5 percent below 2021. Georgia all goat inventory totaled 64,000 head, down 2 percent from the previous year. In South Carolina, the goat inventory was up 6 percent to 36,400 head.
