Dear Western NY Neighbor,

Like virtually every organization has done over the past two years, the American Red Cross of Western New York continues to navigate the challenges presented by the Covid-19 pandemic while also striving to maintain the vital community support that helps us deliver our life-saving mission to our friends and neighbors. Starting March 27, we will be hosting our **first Western New York Regional Auction**, called **March Mission Madness**, which we hope will raise the necessary support needed to continue to bring essential services to those in need.

You likely recognize the Red Cross as an organization that collects and distributes life-saving blood products, or the organization that sends staff and volunteers to respond to catastrophic disasters such as hurricanes, tornados and wildfires, both domestic and international. However, **there is so much more to your regional Red Cross** and what we provide. In our last fiscal year alone, the Red Cross of WNY:

- Responded to **936 regional disasters**, the vast majority of which were home fires
- Provided assistance to **1,600 families** impacted by those disasters
- Installed nearly **1,500 free smoke alarms** in homes that were lacking, making those families safer
- Educated approximately **1,900 children in fire safety essentials** through our Pillowcase Project
- Opened **2,170 cases** related to the various needs of our military members and families through our **Service to the Armed Forces (SAF) Program** that serves members of our armed forces from the time they enlist through the rest of their lives.
- **Provided training to nearly 38,000 enrollees** in potentially lifesaving courses such as CPR, First Aid, Aquatics and Caregiving

Without the support of our community, we can't continue to provide the levels of support that those we serve in their most difficult hours deserve and have come to expect. That's why we're asking you to participate in our **Regional Auction, which will run through April 2**, and take a chance on some great items provided by our caring and generous sponsors.
