Like virtually every organization has done over the past two years, the American Red Cross of Western New York continues to navigate the challenges presented by the Covid-19 pandemic while also striving to maintain the vital community support that helps us deliver our life-saving mission to our friends and neighbors. - Provided training to nearly 38,000 enrollees in potentially lifesaving courses such as CPR, First Aid, Aquatics and Caregiving


